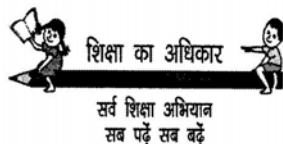

Subject: Regarding Swachh Bharat Swachh Vidyalaya Abhiyan
Madam,

With reference to your letter dated 25th September, 2014 regarding above-cited subject, all district level officials of School Education Department of Uttarakhand have been instructed accordingly.

Although, the Uttarakhand UDISE 2013-14 reveals much higher number of schools without Girls toilet as well as Boys' toilets, the final figures as confirmed by the district authorities are being shown in a tabular form as under:-

This verification has been done by the district level officials of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan and the U-DISE data has been updated.

The reasons for the difference between UDISE 2013-14 and the one mentioned in the table above are on account of the following-

- (i) Schools having 01 workable toilet out of 02 toilet structures, were using workable toilets as common toilet, have now been enlisted as boys toilet.
- (ii) In some schools such non-functional toilets have been repaired by the SMC's with School Maintenance Grant or from some other resources.

- (iii) The UDISE 2013-14 did not capture all toilets in which work was in-progress. As on date, the construction is complete in these toilets.
- (iv) It is significant that although there is a toilet structure available in 13258 schools, but are more or less non functional due to lack of running water facility and miscellaneous damages like seat, pit and plaster damage etc.

We are trying to get these toilets constructed / repaired with the help of funds from CSR as directed by Govt. of India, and shall also propose the gap under the State Sector.

This information is being sent for your kind perusal and necessary guidance please.


